The camp program is based on 3 orientations:



Educational and pedagogical activities



Physical and sports activities



Cultural activities: Armenian music and dance, tourism, visits to historical monuments and Armenian heritage.

Fun activities will be developed around the safety and health of children:

- Road safety
- First aid in case of drowning
- First aid for wounds and scratches
- Food: benefits and dangers
- What to do when you are bitten by an insect?
- Sunstroke: Symptoms and first aid
- Foot and hand hygiene
- safety at home, in the street, in transport
- The respect of safety rules in aquatic areas
- Water: the source of life



Children's well-being: a priority



The teaching team's mission is to create optimal living conditions in the camp to ensure a fair organisation of leisure activities, the acquisition of cognitive skills, the development of their general culture and psychological support adapted to each child.



Health care in the camp is provided by the nurse who is responsible for:

- the organisation and service of meals
- the implementation of physical education and sports exercises
- hygiene
- prevention of epidemics, awareness-raising actions
- health supervision of excursions.

The summer camp covers a large part of the meals:

Meals are made by two experienced cooks who put their skills at the service of children's development with the preparation of gourmet, balanced and healthy meals.



Discovering Armenian heritage






For a month, each child gets to do 5 excursions in oder to discover Armenian historical and natural heritage:
